Confidence

I've been working my way toward attaining my CDL license for the past few months to be able to drive the cross country and track teams to their meets. There aren't enough bus drivers, so I figured if I'm already going to be there why not drive the bus? I sat through two Saturday classes, spent several hours driving, and finally took my test this past week.

There were three parts to the test. The first part was the pre-trip inspection, second was the skills portion, and the last part was the road test. I was

most worried about the pre-trip inspection and using the proper wording for each part of the inspection, such as "All the lenses and reflectors are properly installed and are not cracked broken or missing." Before starting I even told my evaluator that my hands were sweating. But, lo and behold, I passed that portion of the test. I exhaled a big sigh of relief as we prepared for the skills portion of the test.

I sat behind the wheel and guided the bus forward and backward through the cones - my confidence was growing. As we started the final portion of the test, the road test, I felt my body relax and the tension release from my shoulders. I knew I was going to pass.

I completed the student drop-off, and as we approached the railroad crossing I explained everything I needed to do to safely cross the tracks. I executed it flawlessly, or so I thought. As soon as we crossed the tracks my evaluator told me, "I'm sorry but you'll need to come back." I was in shock. "Really?" I asked her. In all my confidence, I made the simple mistake of pulling up too close to the railroad crossing. The front of the school bus was over the white line, an automatic failure. I couldn't believe I had made such a dumb mistake.

That experience made me think of other times in my life when my confidence, or overconfidence, caused me to stumble because I thought I could handle whatever was in front of me. The times in my life when I was least confident and most nervous were the times I turned to God for help and performed the best. I think it's because I wasn't making it about me and I was looking for help beyond myself from the one who created me.

I went back two days later and retook the driving portion of my test. I was more alert of my surroundings, much more humble, and conscious of my need for God's presence. I passed and now have my CDL. And you can be sure I'll stop behind that white line from now on!

Nicolas Yaro - Lehigh Carbon Community College



Wills for Heroes is a free and easy service that provides Wills, Living Wills, Health Care and Financial Powers of Attorney to first responders and military veterans and their spouses/partners.

On September 20, 2025, volunteer lawyers will be conducting a Wills for Heroes Program for all active and retired Pennsylvania First Responders of Carbon County and surrounding companies, all sworn personnel and their spouses/significant others as well as Pennsylvania military veterans (please note that proof of affiliation will be requested at the event - DD214 for military). The event will be held at the American Legion Post 314, 381 Bridge St. Lehighton, PA beginning at 11am. Appointments for each person last approximately 1 hour and at the conclusion of it you will have notarized legal documents - a Will, Living Will, and Health Care and Financial Powers of Attorney (or any combination thereof). If you select that you are coming with a spouse/significant other you will have back to back appointments, and the computer will automatically schedule a second appointment. You do not need to schedule a separate appointment. Please schedule your appointment early as this event is sure to fill up fast. Must be a PA resident for participate in this program.
