

## **Hunger**

As I sit at my desk at Dinkey writing this article, I am hungry. It's lunchtime but I have no lunch with me. I'll need to go home and grab something after finishing this article. There are some pretzels to hold me over, but nothing substantial.

At St. John's there are always lots of candy bars around (Thanks, Robby!). The problem is that I gave up eating those candy bars for Lent. Actually, not just those candy bars but all candy bars. I did the same thing last year during Lent because I get in the habit of grabbing one, or three, every time I walk by the jar. It's not the healthiest choice, so I'm just trying to get in the habit of making better decisions about the food I eat. That doesn't mean I've been perfect this Lent.

At the last midweek Lenten worship I stood over the dessert table eyeing the many goodies on the table. The Tandy Cakes look especially good! Two others were standing there with me, so asked them if the Tandy Cakes counted as a candy bar. "Well, the chocolate is from melted Hershey bars," said one those people there. The other looked right at me and said, "No, you can't have them," when I explained my Lenten dilemma. She was right.

Unfortunately, I had already partaken of some Tandy Cakes during one of the previous midweek services without even thinking about it. It was completely unintentional. Did that momentary lack of focus ruin my entire Lenten journey? I don't think so. The purpose for the disciplines of Lent (fasting, prayer, almsgiving) is to engrain in us something deep and more meaningful – a strengthened relationship with God and the people around us.

My hunger at this moment could lead me to make a hasty choice of grabbing a candy bar. Not necessarily the end of the world. Whereas my hunger for a sense of security or accomplishment could lead me to surround myself with things that help me feel better in the moment but only really scrape the surface of what is truly important and leave me hungering for more. That level of hunger can only be satisfied by God's love and grace.

Where does your Lenten journey stand? Have you been diligent in your Lenten disciplines? Have there been moments of weakness or lack of focus? Perfect execution of the disciplines is not the goal, so please don't beat yourself up if you have not fulfilled everything perfectly. God knows your heart. I pray your Lenten journey has been an opportunity for your faith to be deepened and your trust in God to be strengthened. That will be something to celebrate on Easter morning.
